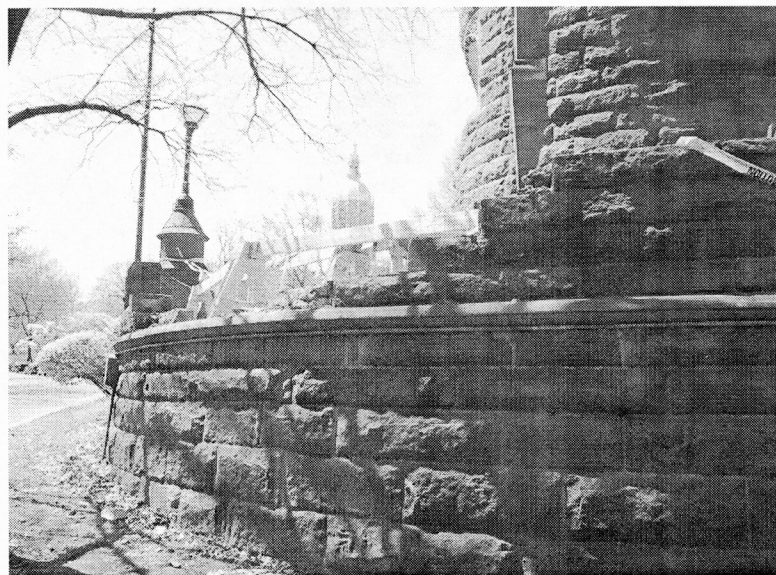

## Structural Restoration Contractor

G&L Capasso Restoration, Inc.

The Bushnell Park Foundation worked in collaboration with the City of Hartford to repair the Arch. The Foundation received private donations to repair the damaged wall and also funded the following additional repairs to the Soldiers & Sailors Memorial Arch:

- Rebuilt the curved brownstone parapet wall that was struck by an unknown vehicle & repaired its ornamental railings.
- Cleaned all of the low brownstone parapet walls located on both the east and west sides of Trinity St.
- Sanded & painted all existing ornamental metal railings & lampposts on the low parapet walls along Trinity St.
- Removed deteriorated or loose mortar from the brownstone parapet walls along Trinity St. and spot pointed these joints.
