Restoration Efforts Bring New Life To Wall

G&L Cappasso Restoration Co. has been working in recent weeks to repair and restore the historic wall at St. Peter's Episcopal Church on Main Street.

The wall, which separates St. Peter's cemetery from the small town park on the corner of Main Street and Rte. 70, was built in the 1870s and is part of Cheshire's "Patriots Walk." Serious deterioration had set in over the years, and put the wall in need of immediate attention.

St. Peter's wishes to acknowledge the Humiston Fund for their generous contribution of \$5,000. Combined with the other generous gifts from the Daughters of the American Revolution, the Sons of the American Revolution, the Jaycees of Cheshire, the Cheshire Garden Club, the Kiwanis Club, individual parishioners of St. Peter's, as well as some individual Cheshire citizens, St. Peter's was able to go forth with the restoration project. The work should be completed soon.
